Descripiton of accommodation

The flat is located in the 2nd district, is 61 m2 and is on the 4th floor. There is a lift in the house. The house was built in the 1960s and was recently thermally renovated.

The flat consists of a living room, a bedroom, a kitchen, a toilet and a bathroom. All rooms are accessible from the anteroom.

Heating/water: There is gas central heating with hot water.





The 1st district is only a few minutes' walk away.

Within a few minutes' walk you can reach a Billa, a Spar, a drugstore, a butcher and the Karmelitermarkt (with a wide range of fruit, vegetables, etc.).

The Danube Canal and the Augarten are also within easy reach, e.g. for walking, running, cycling or enjoying the gastronomy.

The city centre is also easily accessible for museums, bars, restaurants or just to enjoy the city.

At the other end of the street is the "Herminengasse" exit of the U2/U4 station Schottenring, from where you can reach large parts of Vienna without changing trains. With the U2 you can reach the Praterstern station in only 2 stops, where you can also shop on Sundays and public holidays.
